

**POSTPONED: PUBLIC NOTICE/PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD
STATE OF RHODE ISLAND
2020-2024 CONSOLIDATED PLAN**

AND

ANALYSIS OF IMPEDIMENTS TO FAIR HOUSING CHOICE

The public comment period (originally scheduled March 23-April 21) and public hearing (originally scheduled April 8) for the Consolidated Plan and Analysis of Impediments to Fair Housing Choice (AI) have been **postponed** with the approval of U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) until further notice due to the COVID-19 outbreak. An updated schedule will be advertised once more information becomes available.

The Consolidated Plan is required by HUD. It is an assessment of community development and housing needs for low- to moderate-income people in the state and the determination of goals and strategies to address those needs using federal funding. The Analysis of Impediments to Fair Housing Choice (AI) is a review of impediments to fair housing choice in the public and private sector, focusing on laws, regulations, and administrative policies, procedures, and practices.
